Questions & Answers

What causes white spots on enamel?

Those white spots are fluorosis, probably due to excessive fluoride or chlorine in your water. It could also be calcification due to calcium deposits in your enamel. They will initially whiten faster than the rest of your teeth but will even out beautifully as you continue the whitening process.

What Causes Stains?

Some teeth are naturally pigmented or stained as they mature. Typically, stains come from exposure to tea, coffee, smoking, juices, colas, wine, age or just about anything that can stain white material. Tetracycline (antibiotic) can also cause staining.

Are there any side effects?

Some people may feel a little tingling sensation, white gum line, or sensitivity. Vitamin E. serum may be used to alleviate these sensations if they occur.

Is the gel safe?

Research has shown that if the teeth and gums are normal and healthy, there are no adverse effects to bleaching ones teeth. Gels contain high quality ingredients and are made in the U.S.A.



Procedure

After completion of a consultation the technician prepares the mouth piece. Whitening gel is placed on the custom sheath and the mouth piece is placed inside the mouth against the teeth. The system is turned on and that's it!

Three 10 minute sessions are required. Your teeth are evaluated for desired whitening and if no sensitivity occurs the process can be continued for additional whitening as needed.

Questions & Answers

How long does the process take and what are the results?

Results can vary as everyone is different. The grade of your teeth and your age can affect the process, but we recommend a 20-30 minute treatment.

How long before I can eat or drink after my treatment?

For the first 48 hours we recommend you avoid coffee, tea, dark colored sodas, red wines, berries, red sauces, beets or any foods that have the propensity to stain.

How long does the whitening effect last?

This depends on lifestyle. The natural process of staining foods we eat or drink will eventually darken teeth over time and additional whitening sessions will be necessary.

How often can I have this process?

Caution is required not to have teeth over-treated. Once every 3-6 months should be fine. You should consult your dental professional for guidance. Teeth should be in healthy condition before any teeth whitening process.

Will the process whiten my crown?

Stains can be removed from crowns, however they can not be whitened more than the original artificial materials color.
